Additional Information

Location of Games - all mixed U6-U9 Rooball games are at Waramanga. U10+ and Girls Rooball games are played on a home/away basis. Field allocations for games will be displayed on a board near the Canteen each Saturday.

Playing age - is generally based on the calendar year ie. Children turning 6 during the playing year can play in the U6 age group. Sometimes younger players may also be accepted at the discretion of the club eg. a child turning 5 who wishes to play with school friends in the U6 age group. Also, girls playing in mixed teams may choose to play a year down eg. an U7 girl may decide to play in an U6 mixed team.
